Developer FAQ

• Q: No icon presented after my QPKG installed

A:

- 1. Please make sure the "QDK_DATA_DIR_ICONS" field in your "qpkg.conf" is properly set.
- 2. Please be noted: the file name of icons should be exactly identical to the "QPKG_NAME" in "qpkg.conf", e.g. "My_QPKG" and "MY_QPKG" is different.

Q: How to redirect user to my web page after executing QPKG

A:

⇒ Please specify the web page URL in qpkg.conf's "QPKG_WEBUI" filed.

• Q: Images are not presented in my web page

A:

⇒ Please check if the images files are located in correctly path and their access right is properly set.

■ Script

• Q: Failed to execute command within my installation scripts.

A:

⇒ Please use full path to specify the command in scripts, including "getcfg"

Q: How to configure apache to allow CGI execution in my QPKG folder?

A:

- 1. Create a configuration file to permitted execute CGI (Refer to "https://httpd.apache.org/docs/2.4/howto/cgi.html" for more information).
- 2. At the end of /etc/apache/apache.conf, add "Include [your configuration file path]"

■ System Info

 Q: How to let my QPKG automatically executed when system startup?

A:

- 1. Write a shell script to launch you QPKG
- 2. In "/ect/config/qpkg.conf", specify the shell script in "Shell" field.
